Cathedral Schola Cantorum

A devout Catholic immersed in the ancient chants of the church, Charles Tournemire (1870-1939) transformed some of these chants into vast tone-poems for organ, improvised and recorded at the Basilique Ste-Clotilde in Paris in 1930. Transcribed from the phonograph recordings by Maurice Durufle and later by Rupert Gough, they have since become a staple of the organ repertoire. The Cathedral Schola Cantorum will sing the chants that inspired Tournemire's improvisations. Seating is first-come, first-seated.
