## REMEMBRANCE DAY

At 11:00 AM on November 11, 1918, an armistice was signed between Germany and allied nations, ending hostilities of the First World War — a war that would officially end a year later with the Treaty of Versailles. More than 66,000 Canadians were killed in the Great War and more than 172,000 were wounded. Exactly 100 years later, at the 11th hour on this Sunday, Canadians will observe two minutes of silence — as they do every year on this date — to remember all those who gave their lives for their country, all who suffered and died through acts of war, and those who were left behind to grieve and mourn.
