ASH WEDNESDAY

This year, Ash Wednesday will be on March 6 and marks the beginning of Lent. It is a day of **Fasting and Abstinence**.

Fasting (one full meal and two smaller meals, no snacking) applies to those 18-59 years. This does not apply to those who are pregnant, sick or elderly.

Abstinence from meat applies to those 14 and older.

During Lent, the faithful prepare for Easter through prayer, penance and works of charity or mercy.

Ashes will be distributed at all Masses on **Wednesday, March 6** in the Cathedral Basilica. The gentlemen of the Choir school will be singing at the **12:10 PM** Mass and the **5:30 PM** that day. Seating is first come – first seated.

Please note:

Ashes will only be given during the Mass.
