COVID-19 UPDATE

The City of Toronto has announced it has moved to the “Control” stage (Red) of the recently announced Province of Ontario colour coded system (“Keeping Ontario Safe and Open”) to address the spread of Covid-19. The City of Toronto Medical Officer has also announced additional measures on top of the provincial restrictions. As per the direction of His Eminence Cardinal Collins, as of **November 24, 2020**, parishes must restrict attendance at all liturgical celebrations (Mass, Weddings, Funerals, Baptisms, First Holy Communions, Confirmation, etc.) to 50 worshipers in the entire building, excluding those who are involved in ministry (priest, cantor, ushers, etc.). We will continue to ensure strict adherence to sanitization, distancing and other measures as outlined in our protocols.

HUMANITARIAN RELIEF – PHILIPPINES RELIEF EFFORT

Most recently, Typhoon Vamco (known locally as Ulysses) struck the Philippines on **Wednesday, November 11, 2020**, killing 67 people and displacing about 325,000 others from their homes. This was just 10 days after Super Typhoon Goni (known locally as Rolly), one of the strongest typhoons ever recorded, damaged almost 25,000 homes in the Philippines.

The Archdiocese of Toronto has partnered with Development and Peace – Caritas Canada to help the people of the Philippines. Caritas is working to provide essential emergency needs for 9,750 people affected by the typhoons in provinces of Catanduanes and Albay, Philippines.
