## REFLECTING ON THE MEANING OF STEWARDSHIP IN TODAY'S READINGS

This Thanksgiving Weekend let us ponder the following words from Cardinal Collins' Pastoral Letter on Stewardship. "Deep stewardship begins with gratitude and ends with accountability. Stewardship is sometimes called 'the attitude of gratitude.' We recognize gratefully that everything in life is a gift of God ... If each of us is profoundly aware that all is gift, then we are freed from possessiveness, and can be good stewards of what has been entrusted to us in life, sharing generously."
