**CELEBRATION OF MARRIAGE MASS
FEBRUARY 13, 2022**

Marriage Sunday highlights the importance of the sacrament of marriage, affirms couples who strengthen our faith community through their witness.

The Celebration of Marriage Mass will take place on **Sunday, February 13, 2022**, at **St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica** at 2:30 p.m. **Bishop Robert Kasun, CSB** will preside over this special Mass and all married couples will have an opportunity to renew their vows. Due to social distancing measures, in-person attendance is limited at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica and only couples celebrating their milestone 25th, 40th, 50th, 60th, and 60+ wedding anniversaries and one (1) guest per celebrant couple will be able to register to attend (for a total of a group of 3). Other couples, family, and friends are welcome to participate in the celebration via the Livestream. The broadcast will begin at 2:15 p.m.

Registration will close on **February 4, 2022**, or when we reach maximum capacity at the Cathedral.
