## LATEST COVID-19 UPDATES

This past week, the provincial government announced that Ontario will be moving to a modified Step 2 of the Roadmap to Reopening. These changes will take effect as of **Wednesday, January 5, 2022**, with most restrictions lasting a minimum of 21 days.

- Capacity restrictions for places of worship are set at 50% of pre-Covid capacity, and please continue to maintain 2 metres (6 feet) of social distancing.
- Continue to wear a mask indoors at all times, removing it only to receive communion in the location marked on the floor.
- In light of the highly contagious Omicron variant, the Archdiocese strongly recommends against congregational singing at this time.
- Please do not attend Mass at this time if you are feeling unwell, and please do not congregate in large groups before or after Mass, wherever possible.
- A very special thank you to clergy, staff and volunteers for their tireless efforts to serve the faithful and foster a safe environment for all!
