PENTECOST

The Solemnity of Pentecost marks the fulfillment of the Easter season. Last weekend we celebrated Our Lord's ascension into heaven 40 days after the resurrection, and today we commemorate when Christ sent the Holy Spirit, to descend on his Apostles. They all began speaking in diverse languages to evangelize throughout the whole world.

The word Pentecost means "fiftieth", and it is the end of the 50 days of the Easter season. Throughout these 50 days, we have celebrated the resurrection of Christ, his ascension into heaven, and the ongoing ministry of the Church, led by the Apostles and their successors, and guided by the Holy Spirit.

As we prepare to celebrate Trinity Sunday next week, this liturgical season reminds us that God is triune, and that the Holy Trinity is at work in the world in different ways. The Son became incarnate to reconcile us with God the Father, our creator who loves us, and sent the Holy Spirit among us to continue this mission. Going forward into the season of Ordinary Time, we know this time is anything but ordinary.
