PAPAL VISIT TO CANADA

This past week, from **July 24th-29th**, **Pope Francis** made a pastoral visit to Canada on what he described as a “penitential pilgrimage.” The Holy Father visited Alberta, Quebec and Nunavut in order to begin the journey of reconciliation for the role the Catholic Church played in the abuses of the residential school system in Canada.

While in Alberta, Pope Francis met with Indigenous, First Nations, Métis and Inuit peoples and visited the former Ermineskin Residential School. His Holiness offered an apology on behalf of the Church but stated that it was only the first step in ongoing dialogue toward healing and reconciliation.

In Quebec, Pope Francis met state officials, his fellow members of the Society of Jesus, and with delegations from Indigenous peoples of eastern Canada. His final stop was Iqaluit, Nunavut to meet with former students of residential schools in that region.
