CANDLEMAS THURSDAY FEBRUARY 2ND

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord celebrates the presentation of Jesus in the Temple in Jerusalem, 40 days after his birth at Christmas. This feast day is also known as the **Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary**, as women were traditionally purified 40 days after childbirth in ancient Jewish custom. It is also called **Candlemas**, as candles are blessed on this day, representing Christ as a light to all people.

In the passage known as the **Nunc Dimittis** or the **Song of Simeon** in the Gospel of St. Luke, Christ is described as *a light of revelation to the Gentiles, and for glory to your people Israel* (Luke 2:32).

Please join us at any of our regular daily Masses on **Thursday, February 2nd** to celebrate this feast day. You are welcome to bring candles to be blessed at the **12:10 PM** and **5:30 PM Masses**.

ST. BLAISE'S FEAST - FEBRUARY 3RD BLESSING OF THROATS

On **Friday, February 3rd**, the Memorial Feast of St. Blaise, we will be offering the blessing of throats at each of our Masses: **7:30 AM, 12:10 PM and 5:30 PM**.
