Yet, above all, the Lord wants us not to abandon the elderly or to push them to the margins of life."

This year's Day has a close connection with World Youth Day, taking place in Lisbon from August 1 to 6. In Pope Francis' to elders, he invites them to pray for and bless the youth who will participate in WYD, and to young people, urging them to visit and listen to the grandparents and elderly in their community.
