LENT

This is a time for penance and repentance, for almsgiving and prayer, for working to change attitudes that are not pleasing to God. Lent grew out of the penitent order in the Early Church, where people who had committed grave sins would undergo a period of public fasting and penance to become reconciled with the Church. Over time, this developed into a universal practice for all the faithful to prepare for the celebration of the Lord's paschal mystery at Easter.

As we observe Lent, let us reflect on how we can change the things in our lives that get in the way of our relationship with God.
