PASSIONTIDE

The Fifth Sunday of Lent is the beginning of Passiontide, another name for the last two weeks of the Lenten liturgical season. As we draw nearer to Christ's passion and crucifixion, holy images in the church are veiled. Crucifixes are uncovered on Good Friday, and statues and other holy images are veiled until the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS
