PALM SUNDAY

Palm Sunday commemorates Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem. We celebrate with the blessing and distribution of palm branches, which represent the palms people scattered in front of Our Lord as he rode into Jerusalem mounted on a donkey. Palm Sunday also marks the beginning of **Holy Week**, which concludes with the Sacred Paschal Triduum, consisting of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil.

CHRISM MASS

The Chrism Mass will be celebrated by Archbishop Leo and his college of priests on **Tuesday, March 26 at 11:00 AM**. At the Chrism Mass, the Holy Chrism is consecrated and the Oil of the Infirm and the Oil of the Catechumens are blessed for priests to take back to their parishes. The priests of the Archdiocese also renew the promises that they made at their ordination to the Archbishop.

TENEBRAE

All are welcome to join us for Tenebrae on **Wednesday, March 27 at 7:30 PM**. From the Latin word for "darkness," Tenebrae is a service of Matins and Lauds on Wednesday evening of Holy Week. Alumni and Tenor Bass choirs of **St. Michael's Choir School** will sing the responsories set to music by Choir School founder, Msgr. J. E. Ronan.

PASCHAL FAST

To prepare ourselves for Easter, the paschal fast should be observed on Good Friday and continued, where possible, on Holy Saturday. Fasting helps us receive the joys of the Lord's resurrection at Easter with uplifted and responsive hearts. On fast days, people between 18-59 years old are asked to only have one full meal and two smaller meals. Eating meat is not permitted on fast days, but fish and other seafood may be eaten.

Monday, April 1 10:00 AM	EASTER MONDAY (Holiday) Only Mass today. The Cathedral opens at 9:30 AM and closes at 11:30 AM.
