CRYPT CHAPEL RESTORATION/RENOVATION

The Cathedral's Crypt Chapel will undergo its final phase of restoration, continuing from where we left off in 2017. The scope of work will include installation of the floor, ceiling, sound and audio visual systems, as well as upgrades to the HVAC, lighting and electrical systems, and accessibility. The construction work is scheduled to begin on June 10, 2024 and anticipated to last until December 2024, with the goal of reopening for Christmas. During this period the Crypt Chapel will be closed.
