## MISSION CO-OP SPECIAL COLLECTION

Last weekend we welcomed **Fr. Sagara Prishantha** to speak to us about the needs of the poor in his missionary diocese in Sri Lanka. The mission supports young orphan children, as well as those who are physically challenged and those who have suffered physical and sexual abuse. The cost of supporting the 110 children in their 3 group homes is \$400 per child per year. The work of Fr. Sagara's mission helps to bring healing and sustenance to these children with greater love, care, and protection than they have previously known. In addition, there is a growing need for the treatment of *Thalassemia*, a deadly inherited blood disorder, affecting mostly children, for which there is no cure.
