## SEPTEMBER 29, 2024 FEAST DAY OF THE ARCHANGELS

Our Cathedral community celebrates the Solemnity of the Archangels Michael, Gabriel and Raphael on **Sunday, September 29<sup>th</sup>**.

As a leadup to the feast day, Archbishop Leo invites the faithful to join in a Novena to Saint Michael the Archangel beginning **on September 20<sup>th</sup> and ending on September 28<sup>th</sup>**.

*"I am writing in anticipation of the Solemnity of Saint Michael the Archangel which we celebrate on September 29<sup>th</sup>. We have added reason to celebrate the great defender and celestial helper because he is the patron saint of the Archdiocese of Toronto. Last year I invited everyone to join our archdiocesan family in praying the Novena to St. Michael the Archangel in preparation for the feast. I would like to renew my invitation once again this year to pray the Novena."*
