RCIA Registration



The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a program offered to adults who would like to become fully initiated into the life of the Roman Catholic Church through the

Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. It is a step-by-step process of learning about the Catholic faith and is open to adults who are not yet baptized, those baptized in a non-Catholic church, or those who were baptized Catholic but have not yet been fully initiated through Confirmation and/or Holy Communion.

Participation in the **RCIA program begins in September** and involves weekly sessions, Bible reflections, and days of recollection.

Registration opens on Monday August 4.
